with them.



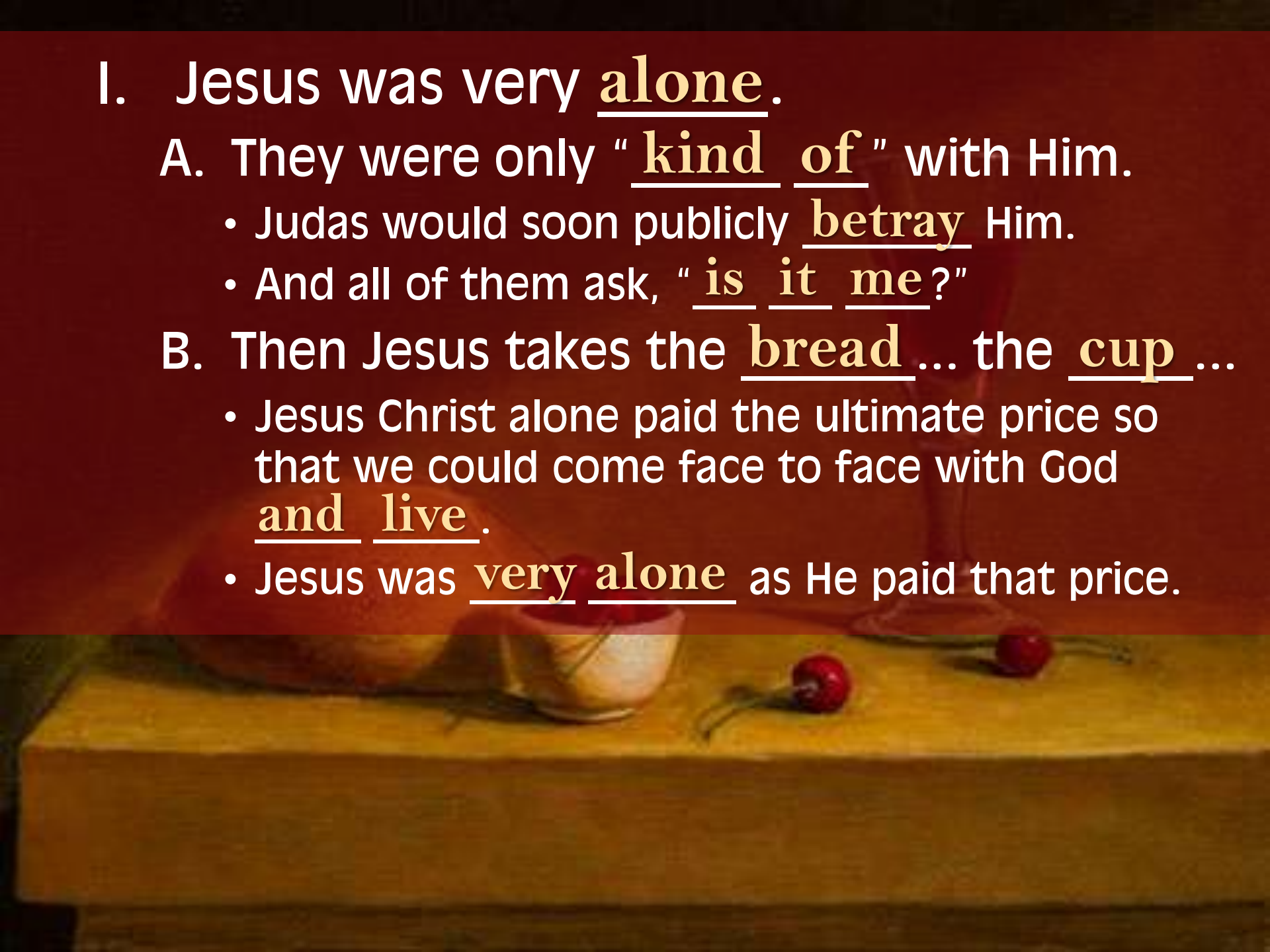
I. Jesus was very alone.

A. They were only "kind of" with Him.

- Judas would soon publicly betray Him.
- And all of them ask, "is it me?"

B. Then Jesus takes the bread ... the cup ...

- Jesus Christ alone paid the ultimate price so that we could come face to face with God and live.
- Jesus was very alone as He paid that price.



II. Jesus was about to be abandoned.

A. All of the disciples were about to fall away.

- The word used for fall away is Skandalizo.
- They had never been with Jesus when He appeared weak.

B. Their world was minutes away from being blown up.

C. We ought to be able to identify with them.

D. None of us has stood firm in every situation.

### III. Jesus was already planning the reunion.

A. Jesus told them the book was not closed there.

B. Jesus was going to redeem and restore those who most notably turned their backs on Him.

C. Consider "The prodigal son..."

- His father was standing out by the road looking and longing to have his son come home.

D. Jesus had to die alone, but that was so that He would not be alone.
