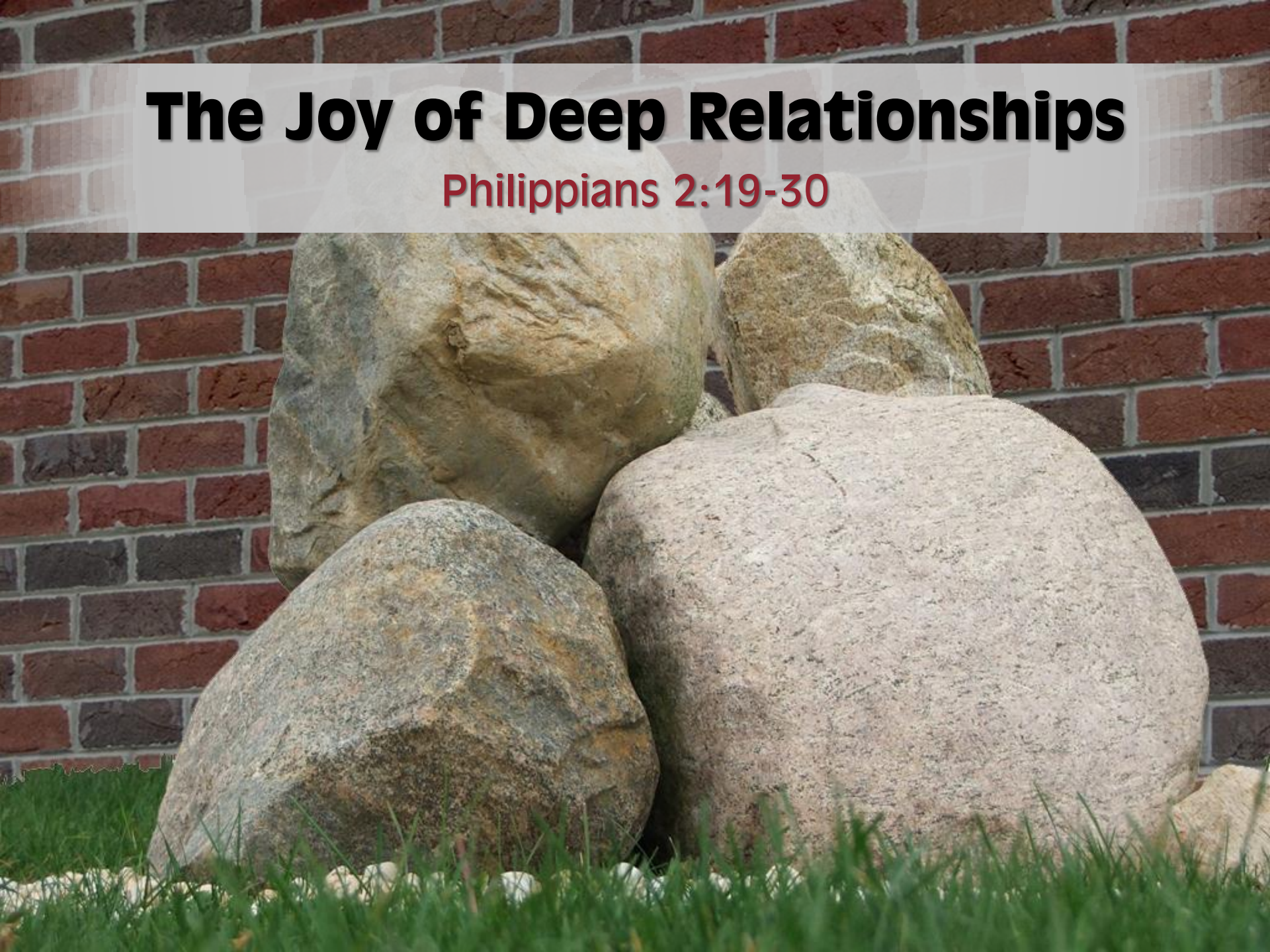

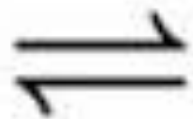

I. Timothy

A. Maintained Godly priorities
